













## Impact of Change Major emphasis on home and community-based services Increased priority on prevention of diseases and promoting wellness Focus on quality rather than quantity of care



33% of SUD and 20% of MH providers have no experience with third-party billing


Less than half of all BH providers have a nationally certified EHR


Few have working agreements with health centers

Many providers lack staff with the required credentials















