SIAC Welcome and Introductions	Commissioner Begley (DBHDID) SIAC Chair called meeting to order and called for introductions of SIAC members, designees, presenters and guests.	
Review of 9/24/2014 SIAC Meeting Summary	KDE noted edit in SIAC Updates related to Project Aware State Districts and Local Districts. Edit noted for summary to be corrected. Motion made and seconded to accept the meeting summary with no changes.	Minutes Adopted with edit noted by KDE.
System of Care “Youth Guided” Care Update- Allie Rigsby (SIAC Youth Member)	<p>Youth Guided Update:</p> <p>Allie presented questions regarding the role of wraparound and RIAC in the new Targeted Case Management regulations. He stated that the Youth Leaders have discussed concerns about wanting to ensure that wraparound will be performed with fidelity.</p> <p>Dr. Brenzel stated that the changes in Medicaid will not diminish the role of the RIAC but open more access to case management.</p> <p>Natalie Kelly addressed the fact that the RIACs will no longer have the function of completing the Map 585 and 586; however, she emphasized that DBH is creating an SED approved verification form that will be used by Behavioral Health providers and it will be recommended to be used by MCOs Allows clinician to verify for RIAC and for the MCO.</p> <p>Commissioner Begley stated that the goal is to create consistency across by creating a single form and including those things in our contracts with MCOs. In order to get where we want to go, there are many things the RIACs need to be involved in for systems change.</p> <p>Allie asked about the new approach to training now that SC101 is ending; he asked if there will be a process to ensure that wraparound is built into TCM training .– Natalie –Kelly stated that the DBH will approve training curriculums; and that DBH is taking the best of what SC101 offered and putting that into policy to make certain it continues.</p> <p>Allie stated that the Youth Leadership very much want to be part of this process.</p> <p>Commissioner Begley assured Allie and the Youth Leaders that all SOC Partners will seek input and guidance from the Youth; they are members of KY’s System of Care.</p>

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<p>Christopher Duckworth, Evaluator KICC Grant (DBHDID)</p>	<p>The site visits bring reality to what is happening statewide and make clear that there is great variety among Regions and the need for a certain degree of autonomy within RIACs. Assessing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ if they working well ➤ what are the challenges ➤ what tools can we assist with to improve cross communication with RIACS ➤ role of RIAC historically and what it will be in the future <p><u>Data/Performance Indicators</u></p> <p>Review of DCBS Out of Home Care Report by RIAC Regions; this data will be reviewed by SIAC regularly. Review of DJJ Out of Home Care Report by RIAC Region; this data will also be reviewed regularly by SIAC.</p> <p>Commissioner Begley - Wanted to give SIAC an idea of where we are going; we want numbers monthly for who are newly in out of home placement and to know if diversion or wraparound is working and to know if there not enough providers. We believe nearly every child can be taken care of in the community so looking at children/ youth recently removed from their homes will be informative...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Want to be able to really see what kind of services are being used in the community, are there providers in the community, and is there fidelity in the community. ➤ Recidivism is also important to watch. – Amy CP ➤ Greatest concern is the movement on a monthly basis into OOHC. ➤ This aids in monitoring RIACs, Fair Teams, and MCOs. ➤ CQI committee can look at detail and the larger SIAC can look at the bigger picture.

Stutler (DJJ)</p>	<p><u>Transition Age Youth Launching Realized Dreams Grant awarded 10/2014</u> <u>Early Interventions-1st Episode Psychosis-national MH Block Grant initiative</u></p> <p><u>Overview of Criminogenic Risk Assessment Tool</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Developed in response to SB 200. ➤ Children and youth were misplaced; both high need and low risk. ➤ Essential to separate risk and need in the assessments. ➤ Want highest cost services to really go to children and youth who are at the most at risk. ➤ Provide risk assessment prior to the disposition of a charge/ a case ➤ Provide treatment following case disposition. ➤ Currently in pilot stage (October/ November of 2014) 	<p>Presentation postponed until 12/10/2014 SIAC</p>

Advisory Council for autism meets 10/23/14. Commission is working on piloting autism clinics. First pilot opens next week. ➤ DPH – Governor’s Office of Early Childhood; curriculum for strengthening families will be piloted in December. ➤ State Family Advisory Council meets on Nov 7-8 ➤ Allie – Working on TAY youth grant work.... ➤ Heather Dearing – FRYSC update – There are several openings on FRYSC Teams for regional program managers; all are posted on the state website. They are also looking for AmeriCorps ... looking at needs within each region for how those volunteers will serve. ➤ EDU – Project Aware grant gearing up. Collecting FRYSC data. ➤ Medicaid – Continuing to work with partners on operationalizing expanded services and expanded network.
