

NEW PROVIDER ORIENTATION

Thank you for your interest in attending the Division of Developmental and Intellectual Disabilities New Provider Orientation. The orientation is designed to give people who are interested in becoming a provider with the Supports for Community Living (SCL) waiver some basic information about the program requirements, expectations and how to navigate through the process. This is a mandatory step for the Executive Director of a potential agency in becoming an SCL Provider. The orientations have been structured into two levels. This structuring was specifically designed to assist you through the process and provide you with information to create a solid foundation from which to develop your agency. You must meet the requirements for each level prior to attendance.
