Standing Committee Meeting Summaries

September 2015

Continuous Quality Improvement

Committee meeting attendees introduced themselves and reviewed the agenda. The meeting began with a review of past SIAC Recommendations to the Governor in order to identify what areas the committee wished to build upon. The group discussed the need for data to be included regarding race disparity at different points of contact in the system of care. The group then discussed potential recommendations to share with SIAC, with those recommendations centering around the transition from out-of-home care to community-based services in the system of care, such as the fidelity of community based services, accountability for services offered, including disparity and disproportionate minority contact information and screening and assessment for appropriate services. Committee member Angela Morris will draft recommendations and share with the committee. Co-Chair Chris Duckworth will share the data dashboard with committee members for feedback before presenting to SIAC at next meeting.

Finance & Resource

Committee meeting attendees introduced themselves and reviewed the agenda. Michelle Kilgore provided and update to the committee on the status of the Financial Mapping process. Following that, the group discussed at length the previous SIAC recommendations and explored potential recommendations the committee wishes to propose in the coming month.

Service Array

Committee meeting attendees introduced themselves and reviewed the agenda. Attendees then finalized proposed recommendations to the Governor and LRC and to present to the full Council. The Chair of the committee, Melissa Goins, reported that she is gathering definitions from several sources for all services listed on the Behavioral Health Service Continuum previously drafted by the group.

System Structure & Governance

Committee meeting attendees introduced themselves and reviewed the agenda. Following that, members reviewed the work of the ad hoc workgroup charged with making recommendations for changes to the Kentucky Revised Statutes that govern the SIAC, RIAC, and LIAC structures. Results from the ad hoc workgroup will be shared with the SIAC members at the October 2015 Commissioner-level meeting. Secondly, standing committee members reviewed previous annual recommendations made to the Governor and LRC and discussed those to be put forth by this standing committee for consideration by the SIAC.

Training & Technical Assistance

Committee meeting attendees introduced themselves and reviewed the agenda. The group then discussed proposed dates for 2016 System of Care Academy (June 8-10 TENTATIVE). The group plans to discuss proposed dates with agency leadership to ensure no conflicts with agency training sessions or mandatory meetings. Members then discussed the progress of the recommendations that were currently in draft form. Following that, the group announced agency sponsored training events.
