Since March 2022, KY law has required that competitive, integrated employment be considered the first and primary option for persons with disabilities of working age who desire to become employed. On October 1, 2024, the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation (OVR) implemented updates to the Supported Employment service fees, increasing the rates for services provided. There are many resources related to integrated community employment to help make the service more accessible for participants, families, and providers.
